Clinton district to use GPS to track school buses

CLINTON, Iowa — The Clinton School District's bus fleet is adopting a new global positioning system to track the buses.

Transportation Director Kenny Mohr said there is minimal cost to the system, with some outside technology funding to help implement the program.

He said it will allow the department to track the buses better. If accidents occur, the district will know when it happened, where the bus is and whether it was stopped or how fast it was going.

The system will help the transportation department to answer parents' questions because they will be able to tell where and when a bus stops on their routes.

The system has been in use on a few buses and should be fully implemented in the near future, the transportation director said.

Mohr says that in the future, the system could be adapted to use "swipe cards" for the bus students to show exactly when and where students boarded the bus and got off.
