

CALIFORNIA PRIVACY POLICY

Policy last updated March 26, 2026

The following terms are the California Privacy Policy of Education Logistics, LLC (“**Edulog**” or “**we**” or “**our**” or “**us**”) for our website (the “**Site**”).

1. Consent

YOUR AGREEMENT TO COMPLY WITH AND BE BOUND BY THESE TERMS IS DEEMED TO OCCUR UPON YOUR FIRST USE OF THE SITE. IF YOU DO NOT AGREE TO BE BOUND BY THESE TERMS, YOU SHOULD STOP USING THE SITE IMMEDIATELY.

2. Introduction

This California Privacy Policy is read together with Privacy Policy and applies only for parties who reside in California (“**Customer**” or “**you**”, or “**your**”). If there is conflict between this Policy and the Privacy Policy, the Policy takes precedent.

3. Information we Collect

Edulog collects information that identifies, relates to, describes, is capable of being associated with, or could reasonably be linked, directly or indirectly, Customer (“**Customer Information**”). In particular, we have collected the following categories of Customer Information from you within the year including your first and last name, email address, postal address, unique personal identifier, online identifier, account name, or other similar identifiers.

4. How we Use your Customer Information

We shall not collect additional categories of Customer Information or use your information for materially different, unrelated, or incompatible purposes without providing you notice. We may use or disclose your information for one or more of the following business purposes:

- a) To fulfill or meet the purpose for which the information is provided.
- b) To provide you with information, products, or services you request from Edulog.
- c) To provide you with email alerts, event registrations and other notices concerning our products or services.
- d) As necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of parties.
- e) To respond to law enforcement, applicable law, court order, or governmental regulations.

5. How we Share your Customer Information

We may disclose your information to a third-party solely for a business purpose; if we do, Edulog shall enter into a contract that describes the purpose and requires the recipient to keep your information confidential and not use it for any purpose except performing the contract. In the year, we have disclosed the following categories of Customer Information for a business purpose: first name and last name, email address, postal address, unique personal identifier, online identifier, account name, or other similar identifiers.

6. Sale of Customer Information

We do not sell any Customer Information.

7. Access to Specific Information and Data Portability Rights

You have the right to request from us certain Customer Information that we collect such as:

- a) The sources of the Customer Information we collected about you.
- b) The categories of Customer Information we collected about you.
- c) The categories of third-parties we share your Customer Information.
- d) The specific pieces of Customer Information we collected about you.
- e) To the extent technically feasible, we shall provide your Customer Information in a readily useable format that allows you to transmit this information to another entity without hindrance.

8. Deletion Request Rights

You have the right to request we delete any of your Customer Information we collected and retained. Once we receive and confirm your request, we shall delete your Customer Information unless we need to:

- a) Complete the transaction for which we collected the Customer Information, provide a product or service you requested, take actions within our business relationship or agreement with you.
- b) Detect security incidents, protect against malicious, deceptive, fraudulent, or illegal activity, or take legal action against those responsible for such activities.
- c) Debug products to identify and repair errors that impair existing intended functionality.
- d) Exercise free speech or exercise another right provided for by law.
- e) Comply with *California Electronic Communications Privacy Act* (Cal. Penal Code § 1546 seq.).
- f) Comply with law or legal obligation.

9. Response Timing

To exercise your right to access, data portability, and deletion as described above, please effect a request as set out in “Contact Us.” We shall respond to a verifiable Customer request within 45 days of receipt. If additional time is required (up to 90 days), we shall inform you of the reason and extension period in writing. Any disclosures we provide shall only cover a one year period preceding your request. If applicable, our response may explain the reasons we cannot comply with your request.

10. Changes to Policy

We may update this Policy from time to time without any notice to you. If we make any changes we shall post an updated Policy on our Site and any updates shall become effective as of the date stated. You are expected to, and you acknowledge and agree that it is your responsibility to carefully review this Policy prior to using the Site, and from time to time, so that you are aware of its current terms. Your continued use of the Site after the “last updated” date will constitute your acceptance of and agreement to any changes and to our collection and sharing of your information according to the then-current Policy. In the event of any conflict between this Policy and any prior versions thereof, the provisions of this Privacy Policy shall prevail.
